Participants selling any item(s), especially food, are responsible for purchasing necessary permits and meeting City health and fire codes. Setup by 8:30 a.m. and tear down by 3:00 p.m. **All artisan's wares must be handmade. Social Distancing and Facial coverings/masks will be enforced. Vendors must display Covid-19 signage and provide hand sanitizer.**
